# OBTAINING THE CODE THROUGH NDA

- Fill out [NDA form](#) with new user information
- Email completed form to [shawn.campbell@nrc.gov](mailto:shawn.campbell@nrc.gov)
- Shawn sends approved NDA to Sandia for processing
- Once all approvals are ready, the user will receive an email with their user name and password

## PROCESS FOR OBTAINING A NEW LICENSE

- Make sure every user has a valid and approved NDA.
- Licenses can only be sent to approved email addresses on file.
- Every license must be renewed annually.
- Run CreateLicenseRequestFile.exe. on each computer and send "license.request" file to [mlr@sandia.gov](mailto:mlr@sandia.gov).
- You can send multiple request files together, I will combine all licenses into one.
- For detailed information on creating a license.request file you can refer to [\\_LicensingReadme.pdf](#) in the MELCOR executable folder.



# BUG REPORTING





## TO REPORT BUGS...

- Send an email to [melcorbugs@sandia.gov](mailto:melcorbugs@sandia.gov)
  - include your information
  - all relevant details of the error
  - screenshots
- The email will generate a JIRA support ticket with all information from your email that will be sent to the developers.
- You will receive a confirmation email
- An automated email will be sent every time the request is moved through the process until it is resolved.
- **IMPORTANT:** Please reply to the original email to keep all corresponding comments in one request.
- The ticket will then generate a GitLab issue that will get worked on.
- DO NOT send another email for the same issue, this will start a new ticket.
- **Coming soon:** We will add updates monthly to the MELCOR website with all current/resolved issues.
